

Plaque Brachytherapy requires a team approach. We will help guide you through the multi-step process outlined below.

- 1. You will be scheduled to see a Radiation Oncologist for a consultation ASAP, and your treatment will be perfromed with his or her insight.
- 2. We request that you consult with a Medical Ocologist at Tennessee Oncology for a physical examination and relevant imaging (CT Scan or MRI; PET Scan in some cases). We will alert Tennessee Oncology with a Referral Request. They will contact you to schedule the appointment. Please make sure all test results and lab work are faxed to Dr. Reichstein's office at 615-983-6010.
- 3. Your Plaque Brachytherapy with Dr. Reichstein will be scheduled in two seperate surgeries:

1st Surgery: Placement of Radiation Plaque and Biopsy

2nd Surgery: Removal of Radiation Plaque

- 4. During the time period BETWEEN surgery sessions, you will be home and free to spend the time as you wish, but please keep the following instructions in mind:
 - a. Avoid ALL direct contact with children
 - b. Keep a distance of 3 feet away from adults
 - c. A patch will be placed over your operative eye, and you are to keep this patch until it is removed by Dr. Reichstein on the day of your 2nd surgery.
- 5. There will be mild discomfort. Please refrain from removing the patch. Prescription medication will be available to ease discomfort. This will be prescribed on the day of your 1st surgery.
